BACHELOR INSTITUTE OF INDIGENOUS TERTIARY EDUCATION (DEDUCTIBLE GIFT RECIPIENT) BY-LAWS 2020

By-laws under the *Batchelor Institute of Indigenous Tertiary Education Act 1999*

1 Citation

These By-laws may be cited as the *Batchelor Institute of Indigenous Tertiary Education (Deductible Gift Recipient) By-laws 2020*.

2 Commencement

These By-laws commence on the day after they are published in the *Gazette*.

3 Revocation or Windup

- (1) If the Institute is wound up or dissolved or its endorsement as a deductible gift recipient is revoked (whichever occurs first) clause 3(2) applies.
- (2) Any surplus of the following assets must be transferred to another organisation with similar objects, which is charitable at law and to which income tax deductible gifts can be made:
 - (a) gifts of money or property for the principal purpose of the Institute;
 - (b) contributions made in relation to an eligible fundraising event held for the principal purpose of the Institute; and
 - (c) money received by Batchelor Institute because of such gifts and contributions.
