WHY CHOOSE BATCHELOR

Batchelor Institute provides a culturally safe learning environment for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people from all Australian states and territories.

Students often speak of Batchelor Institute's "Both-ways" approach that brings together Indigenous Australian and western academic knowledges in a way that embraces respect, tolerance and diversity.

Batchelor Institute's supportive learning environment with small groups help students meet their learning and professional goals. Studying at Batchelor Institute allows interstate students to have a unique learning experience with other Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students in the Northern Territory.

ABOUT THE PTS COURSE

Students attend face to face workshops followed by learning tasks to be completed at home. When not subject to COVID-19 restrictions, travel and accommodation is arranged for Abstudy approved students. During COVID-19 restrictions, however, and whenever a ban on interstate travel remains

in place, alternative means of study have been arranged online. Students engaging in online study must have their own laptop or computer (not phone), or regular and easy access to one at a nearby location (eg friend, school or community centre). They must also have access to a reliable internet connection and a quiet place to study at home or suitable place elsewhere.

PTS prepares adult learners with academic skills and knowledge as well as helping students to build their own confidence and resilience.

Once you complete PTS you will be ready to apply for entry to University.

ELIGIBILITY

All Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who are 18 years or older are eligible to apply. The PTS course is most suitable for adults who have completed at least Year 10 or a Certificate III qualification.
